# 2024-2025 PHS Activities Eligibility Data

I want to thank the Board for your support of activities in PCSD #1. Students' involvement in activities continues to be a key piece to their social development and supports academic achievement. I am excited that we continue to consider participation as a component of our strategic plan and your support is invaluable. Continued evidence supports that students involved in activities outperform their peers who are not involved, and reaffirms the value of activities as a crucial part of an education.

Data: The 2024-25 Eligibility Data attachment:

The top table shows the number of class failures by week of those participating in an activity (except the last column, which shows the non-participants). We pulled eligibility for 29 weeks this school year and recorded the number of participants with one F and the participants with two or more F's during those weeks. We also sorted those failing participants by grade level. So, for example, during week 1 there was one 9<sup>th</sup> grader participating in an activity with one F and two 9<sup>th</sup> grade participants with two or more F's. That week there were eighteen total participants with one F and five participants with two or more. The average at the bottom of the table represents the average number of students per week. For example, we had an average of 4.7 9<sup>th</sup> grade participants failing one class each week.

The second table (highlighted in yellow) reflects grades for participants at the end of the second semester. So, of the students who participated this year, one student failed one class and zero students failed more than one class. If we would have had any participants who failed more than one class this semester, they would not be eligible to participate during the first semester of next year unless they rectify their grade by attending summer school.

The bottom table shows our participation numbers for the past five years. We saw our numbers improve from our 5 year average...this year 75% of our students participated in an activity. Our long standing goal is to have 80% of our students participate in at least one activity, so we continue to aim for this mark. We have consistently had about three quarters of our students participating in an activity.

The Participation Survey attachment...This information on page 1 provides to you a breakdown of gender and grade level participation. For example, you will see that our 9<sup>th</sup> graders led the way this year with 118 out of 139 students choosing to participate in at least one activity (84.8%). The data on page 2 breaks down the participation numbers in athletics for this past school year. The data on page 3 breaks down the participation numbers in activities for this past school year. Our programs continue to be well attended. A note here: We also have activities that are wella attended that are not included in the WHSAA Participation Survey, including the Art Guild and Robotics. We had 2 Robotics teams qualify for Nationals, and the Art Guild has many impressive displays in PHS that are not eligible for State Art Symposium. Those, along with E-Sports and JROTC, provide more opportunities than ever for students to be involved in something outside of the school day.

I would like to thank you all for the continued support. Our activities provide great opportunities for students, and we will continue to pursue excellence as we strive to teach young people not only how to participate in our specific activities, but the life lessons they uniquely provide as well.
