RECOGNIZES

Rural Schools in Park County, Wyoming

A JOINT RESOLUTION of the undersigned members of the Sixty-eighth Legislature of the State of Wyoming recognizes rural schools in Park County Wyoming to include Park County School Districts No. 1, No. 6, and No. 16, each of which provides essential educational services to students in both rural and urban settings.

WHEREAS, rural schools in Park County have been integral to educating our children and are important for keeping rural ranch families together, promoting social cohesion and preserving community identity; and

WHEREAS, our agriculture producers and ranchers play a key role in Park County's economy by feeding families, helping neighbors, and preserving our heritage; and

WHEREAS, Article 7, Section 1 of Wyoming's constitution guarantees that all children in Wyoming have the right to a free public education, stating "The legislature shall provide for the establishment and maintenance of a complete and uniform system of public instruction, embracing free elementary schools of every needed kind and grade, a university with such technical and professional departments as the public good may require and the means of the state allow, and such other institutions as may be necessary"; and

WHEREAS, Park County, Wyoming has seven (7) schools in P.C.S.D. No. 1, two (2) schools in P.C.S.D. No. 6, and one (1) school in P.C.S.D. No. 16 that are identified as rural schools; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNDERSIGNED MEMBERS OF THE SIXTY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING: hereby recognizes and commends the rural schools of Park County, Wyoming, the educators, administrators, and staff for their unwavering commitment to education, community development, and student success, and acknowledges their contributions in shaping the next generation of Wyoming.
